

City Council Report September 1, 2026

1. Met with Morrison Maierle engineers for wastewater plant rehab project.
2. Been working with Brad from Triple Tree on getting everything wrapped up for splash park, I have a list of ticket items that I would like to see complete.
3. Same goes for storm sewer project, I was told they would be back in Aug then Sept 13th is the new date given to me. Once again, they have quite a sizable list of items that need to be completed.
4. Light was installed at splash park; it is supposed to shut off during the day but stays on. Electricians have been notified.
5. Ive been working with Verkada on a trial camera. For our needs I recommend two 5mp outdoor dome cameras with at least 30-day retention time. The MSRP on one camera is \$1,800 and I would recommend a 3-year cloud subscription for \$659 per camera. I have printed out their security information that is also available on their website.
6. Our first testing for PFAS in our drinking water came back with no detection.
7. We have dura patched potholes and asphalt patching has been done.
8. New playground equipment is almost complete at ballfields.
9. We have been fogging for mosquitos at night when wind is down.
10. Started grading alleys when weather permits.
11. We started taking branches hanging in trees in parks.
